Archbishop Timothy Manning will preside at the Enthronement of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, previously announced for Sunday, November 7th. The Enthronement will be held at 4:00 p.m. following an open house on the campus.

ADMISSION OF FRESHMEN IN JANUARY POSSIBLE

In addition to 50 or 60 freshmen who will be admitted to the College in September 1972, the instruction committee has agreed to consider accepting a special section of 15 freshmen on January 31, 1972. These students will take the first semester of the program during the second semester and they will do the work normally included in the second semester during the summer months. They will then become a part of the sophomore class in September 1972.

The project will only be undertaken if 15 students who wish to participate can be found, for only then will it be economically practical. Any student interested in this program should submit an application form immediately. Friends of the College are asked to inform students who might find this program of interest.
